This is the week of Ag-Quip this year, so book accommodation early in Gunnedah and surrounding towns please.

We are pleased to present to you our line-up of forty Poll Santa Gertrudis bulls, with 50% being Homozygous Poll. I feel confident with the overall quality and evenness of the sale team, with an outstanding number of Yarrawonga M134 (PS) and Yarrawonga Quicksilver (PP) bulls represented in the sale draft. We are very proud to offer this year's group of sale bulls and feel they are of the highest quality we have offered, mostly due to the high standard of our own sire battery we are using over our 400 stud cows.

This year we have DNA Genomic Sire tested our sale team so you the buyers can have every confidence in the parentage of the sires you are buying from our Stud. We are offering a range of types of bulls to suit different market requirements and realize not all bull buyers are looking for the same type of bull for their operation. We have aimed to keep abreast of the beef industry and have made considerable investments in poll sires in the past forty years to produce seed stock bulls to suit both the commercial and stud sectors. We have started using our own Homozygous Sires to increase this trait within our own female stud herd, with very pleasing results.

All bulls will have BreedPlan figures to assist you in the selection of the sire to suit your breeding objectives. Also, what must be realised is that we buy in most of our sires from non Breedplan herds, as these bulls have many other traits we are chasing in our herd, and we need to have other genetics coming into the system of Breedplan. The downside of this consequence is it does take a few years to get reliable data on the un- Breedplan, non – proven Breedplan bulls. Due to this most of our sires start below breed average for all their data so it does take a while to get the amount of progeny on the grown and tested to get the accuracy of the Breedplan traits comparable to herds only using Breedplan bred sires.

We will also have raw data figures for weight, DWG, scans for EMA and Fats. The bulls will be Semen collected by Caitlin Warner Australian Premier Genetics and Morphology Tested, at the Australian Premier Genetics Centre. Our aim is to provide paddock reared fit and healthy bulls, so cattlemen can be confident in their bull purchases. DIRECTIONS

With navigators use Keechs Rd Goolhi as a reference point, with google use Benelkay Santa Gertrudis Stud.

FROM GUNNEDAH

From Gunnedah take the Oxley Hwy, 34 km's to Mullaley. Pass through Mullaley on the Oxley Hwy and travel 5km's towards Coonabarabran, then turn right onto the Booloola road, to Goolhi. 15km to Goolhi, turn Left and go 3 km, then turn Right onto Keechs road. 6.5km on Keechs road, (gravel) and follow signs to the sale complex.

FROM NARRABRI

From Narrabri take the Kamilaroi Hwy, 55km to Boggabri.

Take the Grain Valley road, towards Mullaley, for 34km to the cross road intersection.

Turn right at the cross road intersection and travel 17 km to Goolhi.

Go past Goolhi 3km, then turn Right onto Keechs road (gravel) go 6.5km follow the signs to the sale complex.

FROM COONABARABRAN

Take the Oxley Hwy 54km towards Mullaley; turn Left off the Hwy to Goolhi. 10km down the gravel road, turn Left, as you come onto the tar, onto Keechs road (gravel). Go 6.5km on Keechs road; follow the signs to the sale complex.





SALE INFORMATION

HEALTH - VACCINATIONS

7 in 1, Vibrio, AD&E, Multimin and Botulism Vaccinations have been done on the 25.01.2025 and 30.05.2025. All sale bulls have received two shots this year and should receive a booster to fall into your own breeding program.

Benelkay stud is in a Bovine Johne's disease protected clean area. There have never been any traces of this disease detected at our stud's properties. We have completed a Grazing Manual Biosecurity Template, version 1.1 before the 30/06/2017. There has been veterinary oversight into the development of our biosecurity plan, as we aim to remain a J-BAS 6 score.

TREATMENTS

All bulls have been treated on the 25.01.2025 with Ivomec pour and on 30.05.2025 with Cydectin pour on.

FEEDING

The Sale Bulls have been running together in a large mob of about 100 male cattle since weaning. From January 2025 they have been run on native pastures in a sale mob of bulls of around fifty, then split into paddock and Sale bull mobs. Then in May 2025 the bulls have been running on forage oats with a light supplementation of Hay, grain and canola meal.

HANDLING

All bulls are handled with four-wheel motorbikes and dogs. Our bulls have

never been handled with horses. All bulls are quiet but as we all know they can react differently when put into pressure situations or different surroundings, particularly on sale day or being transported as they have never left the property.

SEMEN / MORPHOLOGY TESTS

All bulls have been evaluated for breeding soundness and semen tested by by Caitlin Warner Australian Premier Genetics and Morphology Tested, at The Australian Premier Genetics Centre. Individual morphology results will be available on sale day. .

SCANNING

All bulls have been scanned for EMA, Fat (Rib, Rump, IMF%) and Scrotal Size Measurements, by Bovine Scanning Services (Lonnie Stone). This was done at 400 days old for Breed Plan then again before sale day for their raw data on the supplementary sheet. This will be conducted in early August 2025. The raw data will be available a few days before our sale on social media and our web site as well as hard copies on sale day.

CROSS BREEDING BENEFITS

Benelkay clients are gaining advantages cross breeding using Benelkay Bulls over their British/Euro female herds.

Heterosis or Hybrid Vigour: meaning, difference of performance of vigor of crossbred progeny from the average of the parental breeds.

When looking at breeds of cattle the breeder must consider their country, the environment, where their cattle are run. Their end goals for their cattle and the markets they want to sell to. They also need to be honest with themselves when they consider these realities. Too often, the selection criteria stops at the colour of the coat and or the breed. What breeders need to look at is Weight for Age.

Cattle breeding is all about how much money is in your pocket when you sell your cattle not the highest cents for kg. This is where a crossbreeding program using Benelkay Bulls will pay the bills with increased weight for age, hybrid vigor, fertility and doing ability.

Hybrid Vigour from crossing two British breeds together is of a lower rate. Using a Benelkay Bos Indicus Bull over a British or Euro is a free twenty percent extra weight for doing very little. The more distantly the parental breeds are related, the greater amount of hybrid vigour can be expected.

Hybrid vigour is greater for fitness traits related to reproduction, survival / mortality of cattle (which usually have lower heritability).

Ultimately our final aim should always be "weight of carcass produced in the shortest time possible".

LOOKING AFTER YOUR NEW BULL

We have put a lot into getting your purchase ready with breeding and management and now it is up to you to continue to prepare your considerable investment for the future.

THE FOLLOWING ARE A FEW TIPS

• At auction sales, remember that possession is yours after the fall of the hammer.

• We recommend that you insure your bull - it is a new asset to your property.

• Pen bulls on the truck from different vendors / properties separately.

• Handle him quietly at all times, no buzzers have been used on these bulls.

• Have some cattle in the yard for company to run him with for a week or so to get acquainted to your property. All will be strange to him as he has been taken from his mates and even the water and feed will be different as well as your environment.

• Check the health treatments he has had and that they are appropriate to your area and treat with anything additional you think he might need after he has settled in.

 At joining it is preferable not to mate young bulls multiply with older sires, as they will not allow the young bulls near the cows and they could get injured.

• Try and get him to his selected group of cows preferably in a group with other cattle or bring the group to him.

• Check him regularly, seeing he is walking well, no swelling of joints or in his sheath, if possible that he is serving and that not too many cows are returning to heat.

• If you suspect any problems occurring quick action may cure a problem before it escalates.

• Have a spare bull or bulls available to cover any break downs, do not give the young bull increased numbers of females to cover other breakdowns within the herd. Also young heifers may be in season for less time than cows and you will need more bulls to cover them.

• After the joining remove him and give him any health treatments such as for internal and external parasites and any vaccinations appropriate to your conditions.

• Give him every chance to grow out and develop after his first joining as your Santa bull will continue to grow and be cutting teeth, for at least a further twelve months.

• Annual pre joining vet examination will help with your next joining results.

• Bulls are a large investment for any breeding herd and they have a major effect on herd fertility. A little time and attention to detail to make sure they are fit, free from disease and actively working is well worthwhile and can deliver huge results to our agricultural businesses.

BREEDNG OBJECTIVES / Our breeding objective is to produce structurally correct moderate framed Polled Santas, balanced in fertility traits, weight traits, muscling and fat. Always mindful of maintaining an easy doing functionally efficient and fertile herd, with a broad genetic base to meet the current market needs of our clients and to improve the profit in their operations.

TO ACHIEVE OUR OBJECTIVES WE EMPLOY THE FOLLOWING STRATEGIES:

FERTILITY

• We don't pamper the stud cow herd; they are run on a commercial basis, in conjunction with cropping. This strategy indicates the cattle that will perform especially for fertility and gives clients confidence that the sires they purchase will perform in any climate.

• Semen and morphology test bulls and use as high a quality tested bull that meets our breeding objectives.

• Maintain soft fine haired cattle. These perform better in our climate and are more fertile.

• Select for cattle with above breed average fat. Fat is important for carcass coverage (MSA), doing ability leading into better fertility.

- Keep a balance between milk and fertility traits.
- Identify sires that have excessive birth weights.

• Select for cattle with tidier sheaths. This gives us much better fertility in both bulls and females also complying better with the MSA requirements.

MATURITY/MEAT QUALITY

- Select for moderate framed cattle with above breed average young growth.
- Select cattle that are able to perform well in a range of markets for clients.
- Our style of Santa Gertrudis cattle are able to target the vealer market, the feed lot and all the way through to the bullock trade.

• Select for quiet temperament for handling and meat quality issues.

INFORMED DECISIONS

• All cattle are performance recorded for as many traits as we can manage, keeping in mind commercial considerations. E.g. we don't scrotal score all male calves as we castrate a large number of bull calves.

• Performance data is used in mating decisions to produce balanced progeny.

STUD FOCUS

<u>RO</u>

With a strong genetic base of 400 classified stud cows. Benelkav is well placed to breed cattle to suit the modern-day commercial cattleman. With a strong emphasis on poll cattle that can have the ability to enhance the carcase traits in the stud and commercial cattle industry. We have selected and used only poll sires for over Forty years giving us a large genetic poll base to draw from. This year's sale team will have about half Homozygous (PP) bulls represented which gives the industry an opportunity to be able to purchase sires to fast track their own herds towards poll genetics. These results will be on the supplementary sheet or ring us presale. The Benelkay stud is run on a commercial basis with no favouritism. With years of work going into the fertility, temperament, and the need to breed cattle that are soft, easy doing and are saleable all year round. We have found this style of cattle can compete with and better other breeds but still retain the excellent attributes of the Santa Gertrudis Breed. We have noted over time that moderate cows have the best fertility, and we can move a little each way with size to suit the needs of most beef markets. Our entire herd is performance recorded, all stud and commercial cows with Santa Gertrudis Group Breedplan. We find Breedplan, a useful tool in our herd selection, as well as using visual assessment.

Both tools enable us to make fast gains in the desired traits we believe our herd needs to be achieving.

Sires in the past years making an impact on our stud's direction, have been, Sanford Vale Juggler (P). Wave Hill F73 (PS), Wave Hill Napperby (P), Bullamakinka H82 (PS) and Bullamakinka Dreamtime (P). Also, SuJo First Class (P) who has proved to be a wonderful sire, taking the stud forward in the direction, we believe the industry needed to be heading. His progeny has had a huge impact within the stud, and we are still benefiting from his strong bloodlines. Yarrawonga M134 (PS) and Burramurra Boss 152 (PP) are both creating their own history within the stud in the last few seasons with outstanding results, this will be the last drop of sons for both of these bulls.

Every year we try to bring new genetics into the sale for our clients. This year we are proud to introduce new Sires Cree Papalii S146 (PS), Strathmore Senator S498 (P), Dangarfield El Nino E119 (P) and Benelkay Sniper S266 (P) they have all introduced fresh genetics into our herd and have contributed to the sale team very positively.



YARRAWONGA M134 (PS)

Purchased at lot 4 for \$38,000 in the 2017 Yarrawonga Waco Annual Bull Sale. M134 (PS) a son of Waco Zeus, at 25 months he weighed 900kgs, DWG 1.20, EMA 121, 40 cm scrotal and had a 93% morphology. Purchased for his Santa Gertrudis phenotype, thickness, depth, heavy bone, and quiet disposition. M134 has become our go to sire, he has exceptional fertility siring over eighty calves in a single season. Placing him as the top sire for progeny recorded in one season within the Santa Gertrudis Breed. He has developed into a mountain of a bull and is breeding exceptional progeny both male and female, with his classification rate of his progeny being well over 90%. He is producing what we are aiming for with his consistency of breeding quality, strong poll cattle that carry all the attributes producers are looking for in Santa Gertrudis cattle. Top priced son to date is Benelkay Renovator R014 (PP) who sold for \$50,000 to Ben and Amanda Adams Dangarfield Santa Gertrudis Stud in 2022. In the 2022 sale his twenty-one sons sold to average \$15,500 with eleven of these selling into studs. This will be the last offering of M134 sons.

He has developed into a big strong sire with plenty of length and scale. We were attracted to his sire Restdown 378 (P) when Yarrawonga purchased him and thought we would purchase one of his sons. He is breeding very dark coated stock with strong breed type, there is a strong representation of his sons on offer this year. A Sire that can really produce some punch in his offspring, with strong breed phenotype.

Boss a Homozygous poll was purchased as a led bull at the 2016 Santa Central Sale for \$17,000. Weighing 891kgs at 22months with a DWG of 1.30kg, Scrotal of 40cm and an EMA of 122. After watching him win his class at the Ekka we thought we would purchase him for his out cross genetics, growth, tropical dark skin type and quiet temperament. Boss has grown into an eye appealing sire, great thickness, and good depth with plenty of scale. He has thrown progeny with strong breed character, and we are seeing strong results through his females in the breeding program. Boss produces exceptional females with scale and breed phenotype. We are pleased with both his male and female progeny. Top priced son to date is Benelkay Quartermaster Q012 (P) selling to Jock Cunningham "Hallcraig Santas" for \$30,000 in 2021. Boss is a sire that throws consistency in his progeny producing scale, thickness and heavy bone progeny with dark red coat colour that is hard to purchase. It is pleasing to see his sons making an impact in the studs they have been sold into. This will be the last year of Boss progeny.
